



(NEW) ICF WORLD UNIVERSITY CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT 2018

Final Selection Criteria Approved by the Sprint Racing Council – February 22, 2018

1. Performance Objectives

The following 2018 ICF University World Championships Team Selection Criteria are guided by CKC's performance objectives where an athlete demonstrates the ability/potential to make a Top 8 at the U23 World Championships and be progressing toward the podium at Senior World Championships and Olympic Games.

2. Selection Overview

- 2.1 The 2018 ICF University World Championships will take place August 10-12 in Szolnok, Hungary.

- 2.2 Athletes must meet the eligibility requirements to participate in the ICF University World Championships according to FISU regulations. For more information on eligibility please go to the FISU website: <http://www.fisu.net/>
- 2.3 Please note: This is a self-pay event.
- 2.4 The 2018 competitions that will be used in the selection of the Team are:
 - 2.4.1 National Team Trials #2, May 18-20, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia
 - 2.4.2 National Team Trials #3, June 22-24, Montreal, Quebec
- 2.5 The Team maximums will be as follows:
 - 2.5.1 Women's Kayak 6
 - 2.5.2 Women's Canoe 3

2.5.3 Men's Kayak 7

2.5.4 Men's Canoe 3

2.6 Athletes will be nominated as follows:

2.6.1 Eligible athletes nominated to the U23 World Championship Team

2.6.2 Athletes according to National Rank in each Discipline at the conclusion of NTT3 as follows:

2.6.2.1 Women's K1 200/500m (max of 6)

2.6.2.2 Women's C1 200/500m (max of 3)

2.6.2.3 Men's K1 1000m (max of 3)

2.6.2.4 Men's K1 200/500m (max of 4)

2.6.2.5 Men's C1 1000m (max of 3)

2.6.3 Athletes who are nominated to the Senior World Cup Team will not be at NTT2 and therefore each Senior World Cup athlete will be allocated points at NTT2 according to their position of finish on the relevant ranking list at NTT1. Athletes who compete at NTT2 will score points as if the World Cup team is present and recorded the same position of finish. Example A: Athletes named to the World Cup Team finish 1st through 6th at NTT1 therefore the winner of NTT2 would score 7th place points. Example B: 1st through 4th and 6th are selected to the World Cup Team therefore if the 5th place finisher is also the 1st place finisher at NTT2 then they would score 5th place points. All other athletes in this scenario would score 7th place points or lower depending on their position of finish at NTT2.

2.6.4 Points will be applied to the position of finish with 1st place scoring 18 points, 2nd place 17 points, 3rd place 16 points, and so on. The scores from trials races are added to establish an overall score. Athletes will be ranked according to this combined score.

2.6.5 Only results from the final at any trials will be used. Race-off results related to team selections will not be considered;

2.6.6 The number of athletes selected in each discipline will be dependent on:

2.6.6.1 The event schedule

2.6.6.2 Must rank in the top 16 on the National Discipline Ranking List.
