CKC MEDICAL FORM

CKC PRIVACY POLICY

CKC is responsible for maintaining and protecting your medical information in accordance with Canada's privacy and personal health information protection laws. The purpose for which your information is being collected is to ensure that we can provide you with appropriate medical care in emergency situations. CKC will only use and disclose your information only for these purposes or when required to do so by law. Except in emergency situations where the sharing of your medical information may be necessary in the best interests of your health, your medical information will not be shared with anyone without your prior consent.

We will retain your medical information until you are no longer actively involved in CKC's National Team Programs.

In accordance with Canada's privacy and personal health information protection laws, we protect your medical information with appropriate safeguards and security measures. Our employees and service providers have access to your medical information for the purposes identified above and access is permitted only to the extent that is necessary for such purposes. In addition, we have taken several measures to protect your information, such as restricting physical access to our offices and using computer passwords and file encryption for on-line activities.

ANTI-DOPING

Please be aware that if you are taking any medications – in particular asthma medications – you must ensure that you have the proper documentation to be allowed to use those medications while on international teams.

Visit the Global DRO website (www.globaldro.com) as soon as possible to find out if your medications are considered prohibited in- or out-of-competition. If they are prohibited, you will need to apply for a TUE (Therapeutic-Use-Exemption). For asthma sufferers, you may need to organize pulmonary function tests prior to leaving. This process takes time so please ensure you check any medications you are taking ASAP.

TUE applications are typically due to the ICF within 21 days of the start of the competition.

IMPORTANT – even if you currently have an approved TUE from CCES, you will also need to submit one to the ICF if you are competing internationally at an ICF event.

Note that supplements are not regulated and therefore will not show up in the Global DRO database. We encourage you to check any supplements that you might be taking on the “[NSF – Certified for Sport](http://www.nsf.org)” (<http://www.nsf.org>) website prior to taking anything. Some supplements may contain ingredients that trigger a positive doping result so please be very cautious.

You are responsible for anything you take and are personally responsible for the presence of a prohibited substance in your body. If you do not file a TUE application and subsequently test positive for the prohibited substance, you could be found guilty of an anti-doping violation and face serious sanctions.
