



BRANDENBURG INTERNATIONAL REGATTA CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT 2019

Final Selection Criteria Approved by the Sprint Racing Council – February 5, 2019

INTRODUCTION

1. General

These criteria supplements are subject to the principles and procedures as outlined in the National Team Selection Procedures 2019 - Sprint Document found on the [CKC Website](#).

2. Performance Objectives

The following 2019 Brandenburg International Regatta selection criteria are guided by CKC's performance objectives where a crew demonstrates the ability/potential to make a Top 8 finish in an Olympic event at the competition for which they are being considered. The Brandenburg Regatta has prioritized the U21 athlete group with a specific selection focus on crew performance in K2 and C2. This regatta will also be used as part of preparation for athletes selected to the Junior World Championship Team at NTT#1.

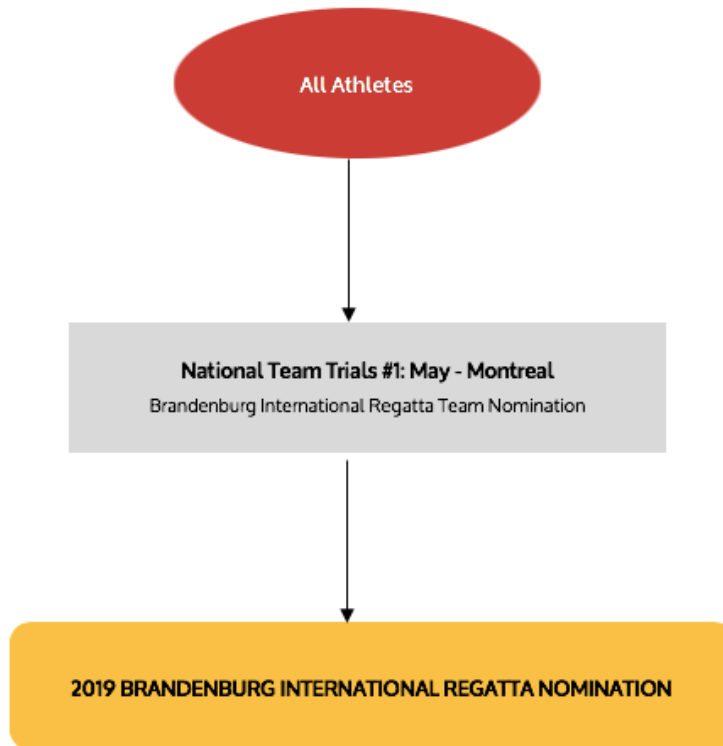
The Brandenburg International Regatta competition takes place May 24-26, 2019.

3. Selection Procedures

3.1 Eligibility

3.1.1 To be an eligible the last year that a competitor can compete in the U21 category is the year that their 21st birthday falls in. (i.e. born on or after January 1st 1998)

3.2 To assist athletes/crews and coaches, an overview of the selection process is provided below. This chart is an outline of the various paths toward nomination to the Team. The chart is only a guideline and one should review thoroughly the criteria that follows:



- 3.3 A U21 crew that earns a Top 3 finish in the open K2 or C2 events at NTT1 will be nominated. (Note: Both athletes must be U21 eligible). Note: the top 2 finishers at NTT1 will be nominated to the Senior World Championship Discipline Pool (World Cup Team).
- 3.4. Athletes / Crews selected to the Junior World Championship Team at NTT1.
- 3.5 Final nominations to the team will occur on or before May 15, 2019.
- 3.6 All entries at the Brandenburg Regatta will be approved by the HC.
