



### **Job Posting #3, SPRINT CANOE AND KAYAK COACH**

The Muskoka Paddle Club is accepting applications for the position of a sprint racing coach. Experience in war canoe, north canoe and marathon racing would be an asset. MPC is located in Kelvin Grove Park in downtown Bracebridge on the main branch of the Muskoka River.

Start date is July 2, 2019 (or earlier) to August 23, 2019. Anticipated hours are expected to be from 1:00 pm to 9:00 pm daily, Monday to Friday. Additional hours will be available in May and June to recruit youth at Elementary and High schools in Bracebridge. Rate of pay is negotiable based on experience.

#### **Responsibilities Include:**

- Teaching youth safe boat handling
- On water and on land supervision and sprint racing instruction
- Be able to demonstrate and teach proper paddle technique
- Occasionally sign out boats and equipment to members

#### **Requirement:**

- Community Coach Certification
- NCCP Competitive Coach with Canoe Kayak Stream preferred or prepared to take it this spring.
- ORCKA or other certification would be considered
- Strong competitive paddling background
- Ability to work with all ages of paddlers
- CPR and First Aid certification
- Pleasure Craft Operator Card
- Acceptable criminal background check
- Minimum age 16 to maximum age 30 for staffing grant purposes. This would be the ideal position for an experienced sprint or marathon paddler who summers or lives in Muskoka.
