CANOE SLALOM SENIOR NATIONAL TEAM 2019 SELECTION CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT

1. Selection Procedures

The selection process laid out in this document must be read in combination with the 2019 Canoe Slalom and Extreme Slalom Selection Procedures and the National Team Trials Ranking System.

2. National Team Trials

The selection of the Senior Canoe Slalom National Team will be determined using the following four selection races held at the Riversport Rapids Whitewater park in Oklahoma City.

5. Selection Criteria

- 5.1 Nomination to the Senior National Team will be determined based on the National Team Trials Senior Intraclass Ranking after completion of the National Team Trials.
 - 5.1.1 The first ranked Athlete/Crew in each Event will be awarded the first Quota in their respective Event.
 - 5.1.2 The second ranked Athlete/Crew in each Event will be awarded the second Quota in their respective Event.
 - 5.1.3 The third ranked Athlete/Crew in each Event will be awarded the third Quota in their respective Event and so on until all Quota in each Event are exhausted.
- 5.2 Nomination to the Senior National Team is dependent on Athletes/Crews meeting the appropriate Performance Benchmark and Eligibility Requirements described in the Canoe Slalom and Extreme Slalom Selection Procedures.
- 5.3 Athlete(s) nominated to the Canoe Slalom K1 event will also be nominated to compete in the Extreme Slalom K1 event in a top-down fashion based on the National Team Trials Senior Intraclass Ranking.
- 5.4 Replacements will be made using the Replacement Procedures described in the Canoe Slalom and Extreme Slalom Selection Procedures.
