ORGANIZATION

Canoe Kayak Saskatchewan (CKS) is the provincial sport governing body for the sport of canoe-kayak in the province. CKS promotes participation in canoe-kayak sports and advances excellence through development, funding and support for athletes, coaches, volunteers and officials in Saskatchewan.

DESCRIPTION

Working in partnership with CKS and the Provincial Coach South, the Provincial Coach North will primarily be responsible for developing, implementing, monitoring and evaluating the provincial sprint high performance training program. This will include developmental programs aimed at increasing the pool of high performance athletes at the Saskatoon Racing Canoe Club and northern paddling clubs in the province.

CERTIFICATIONS

- NCCP Competition Development is **required**. If this certification is not satisfied at the time of hiring, the successful candidate must provide a written plan for completing the certification requirement by February 2021 as a condition of hiring
- Successful applicants will need to provide:
 - Criminal record and vulnerable sector check, current within 3 months.
 - Respect in Sport certification number.
